Dr. Marcel Mindrescu, University of Suceava, visited the University of Vermont (UVM) June 5 to 10, 2016. The trip and visit were funded by a grant from the Trust for Mutual Understanding (W.I. Keeton, P.I.). While at UVM, Dr. Mindrescu met with the Director of the Gund Institute (Dr. T.
